



PRIVATE TOUR - Min. 2pax / Max 4 pax

Daily Departures (from 31 March to 31 October)



DAY 1

Arriving at Lisbon Airport, head to the rent-a-car office to pick up your car rental. Crossing the Vasco da Gama Bridge over the Tagus River, heading south on the A12 motorway and then on the A6 towards Évora, the capital of the Alentejo region and classified by Unesco as World Heritage. Overnight at Pousada dos Loios, located in the historical center of the city, originally a 15th century Convent that has been carefully restored.

DAY 2

After breakfast, head to the Evora Tourism Office in the main square of the city (Plaza Geraldo) before 10:00 a.m., where an official guide, on a half day walk, will show you the city points of interest: the Roman Temple to Diana, the Church of San Francisco and the Chapel of Bones. Rest of the day at leisure. Enjoy this magnificent city, protected by UNESCO. Accommodation at Pousada dos Loios.

DAY 3

After breakfast, drive your car to Reguengos de Monsaraz, considered one of the oldest villas in Portugal. It is an open museum: the medieval Castle and its Tower, the "Old Audience Courts (14th / 16th centuries) and the Mother Church. Go to the top of the village and have a lunch in one of the cozy "bistros". Enjoy the beauty of the landscape. After lunch, drive back to Vila Viçosa, where the Dukes of Bragança (Portuguese Crown) remained for centuries - Ducal Palace- until the proclamation of the Republic in 1910. Accommodation in the Pousada of Vila Viçosa, located in the city historical center. Very characteristic for its labyrinthine themed rooms, this Pousada recovered in full the successive and overlapping constructions of cells, retreats and oratories, ordered to be erected by the nuns who collected the convent. Accommodation.

DAY 4

Enjoy this historic city by visiting the Palace (Paço Ducal). Before lunch drive about 44 km to Estremoz, known worldwide as the capital of white marble. Climb up to the castle, built by King D. Dinis for his wife, Queen Santa Isabel, who gives the name to the luxurious Pousada de Estremoz. Enjoy a lunch there. Then, drive about 47 km more to Alter do Chão, known for its stud farms, founded in 1748 by king D. João V, only for breeding and treatment of the famous Lusitano horses. Overnight at "Casa de Campo".



DAY 5 / DAY 6

Alter Stud Farm, formerly the Royal Stud Farm, was founded by King D. João V, with the purpose of improving horse breeding. After 250 years, Coudelaria becomes the oldest in the world to remain uninterruptedly in the same place maintaining the quality of the pure Lusitano horse. The quality and character of the Lusitano horse have been one of the purposes preserved over time. At the moment you have several infrastructures: Interpretation Center, Exhibition Gallery, House of the Trains, Collection of Agricultural Tools. During these two days' time to visit the stud farms, you'll have the opportunity for riding lessons by a specialist, or flipping (if you prefer). Accommodation in two days in the "Casa de Campo" of the Royal Stud Farm.



DAY 7

Departure from Alter do Chão, passing through Estremoz and returning to Lisbon by the motorway, where you should arrive in approximately 2 hours' time and go directly to the Hotel Tivoli Lisboa. Time to rest. Around 2:30 p.m. a panoramic visit of the city: Belem area, where we can find the most beautiful and historical monuments of the fifteenth and sixteenth centuries alluding to the time of discoveries: Belem Tower, Discoveries Pattern, Jerónimos Monastery Church - work on manueline style- and the Carriage Museum, which contain one of the most important and rich collections of carriages in the world. Always next to the river, we will go from the Monumental Lisbon to the Old Lisbon, passing through downtown (Baixa Pombalina) where you can admire the Commerce, Rossio and Restauradores Squares, passing by the Avenida da Liberdade, the "boulevard" of Lisbon, ending at Marques de Pombal Square, the heart of Lisbon. Before leaving this beautiful city, an evening with Fado Dinner. UNESCO classified Fado as the Intangible Heritage of Humanity, being a recognized symbol of Portugal. Fado is, par excellence, the song of Lisbon. Overnight.



DESTINATION MANAGEMENT

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DAY 8

Departure from the hotel to the Lisbon Airport, where you must deliver the car in the rent-a-car company. Departure formalities and fly back home.

Notes

- You can add more hotel nights. Ask for information.
- If you come from an European country, belonging to the EU, bring your driving license.
- Otherwise, in addition to the driving license of your country, also carry the International Driving Certificate.
