



PRIVATE TOUR - Min. 2pax / Max 7 pax

Daily Departures (from 31st March to 31st October)



DAY 1

Arrival at Lisbon Airport and transfer to the hotel. Located in Lisbon downtown, Casa Balthazar is part of the city history. Balthazar, the founder of the famous National Confectionery (the oldest pastry shop in Lisbon), acquired this beautiful property in August 1882. The house, with wonderful views of the castle and Rossio Square, still belongs to the family. Accommodation.

DAY 2

After breakfast, visit the city of Lisbon. First go to Belem area, where you can find the most beautiful and historical monuments from the XV and XVI centuries, alluding to the time of the discoveries: Belem Tower, Discoveries Pattern, Jerónimos Monastery Church - manueline masterpiece - and the Museum of Carriages, which contain one of the most important and rich collections of carriages in the world. Along the Tagus River, you will go from Lisbon Monumental to Old Lisbon, passing through the old and charismatic neighborhood of Alfama. Continue along downtown (Baixa) where we can admire Commerce, Rossio and Restauradores squares, passing through Avenida da Liberdade, the "boulevard" of Lisbon, ending at Marquis de Pombal Square. Time at leisure. In the afternoon jump in the Tram 28, perhaps the most sought touristic attraction in Lisbon: a trip in the old times, climbing hills and medieval streets on old trams that are still part of the Lisbon public transportation network. Simple tickets can be purchased from the driver, but most Portuguese passengers use pre-paid passes, including many foreign tourists who purchase the Lisbon Card (recommended to avoid having to buy a ticket on each trip and to save money).

DAY 3

Why not shopping at Freeport? It is the largest Outlet in Europe, just 30 minutes from Lisbon, passing by one of the most beautiful bridges in Europe, the Vasco

da Gama Bridge, more than 17 km long, is the ideal place for a perfect day. With more than 140 stores, here you can find the best brands at reduced prices, in the most varied areas, from clothing, shoes and perfumes till decoration. You can also find several restaurants, cafes and terraces, accessible to all tastes.

Return to the hotel and time at leisure.

Before leaving this beautiful city, you must have a dinner listening the Fado songs. UNESCO has classified Fado as the Intangible Heritage of Humanity. Fado is, par excellence, the song of Lisbon.

DAY 4



After breakfast, transfer to the Cascais Marina, L16 Pier (have a lunch there before boarding). Before you leave, hotel staff from "The Charm of Cascais" will come and collect your heavier luggage. Take only the essentials. In 3 hours you will reach the Marina of Sesimbra, a pretty fishing village, where the blue of the sea predominates. For dinner, try the best grilled fish in the world at one of the seafront restaurants. Accommodation on board.

DAY 5



Departure from Sesimbra and along the coast enjoy the fantastic scenery of Arrábida Mountain (Natural Park protected area), you will pass through the wonderful Portinho da Arrábida, before arriving at Troia Marina. Enjoy swimming in the beach of Tróia with 20 km of white sand. Return on board and we will come back again sailing to the Cascais Marina, where the hotel staff will be waiting to pick- up you to "The Charm of Cascais" hotel. Accommodation.

DAY 6

Breakfast at hotel. Enjoy strolling in the picturesque city center of Cascais, full cosmopolitan and full of excitement. The Estoril Casino, the largest in Europe, is a good example of this. Accommodation in "The Charm of Cascais".

DAY 7



A full day of car excursion: Guincho beach, Cabo da Roca, the most western point of continental Europe; Sintra and the landscape are a unique place that is classified by UNESCO as a World Heritage Site. Legends, palaces, castles and parks. The Palace of the Village, the Castle of the Moors and the Palace of Pena cannot be missed. At the end of the day return to the hotel for accommodation.
