DAY 1

Arrival at Porto Airport. Assistance and transfer to Hotel Infante de Sagres, considered the most important boutique hotel in Porto, a true icon of sophisticated design and intimate atmosphere. Occupying a building from the 50's that combines a neo-baroque atmosphere and an irreverent contemporary style. This hotel is located in the historical city center. Check-in and time for resting. Accommodation.

DAY 2

In the morning, visit the Northern Capital of Portugal, considered by Unesco as a World Heritage. The city of Porto has one of the most remarkable historical centers in Europe, chosen as the best European destination in 2016. Visit the most important monuments of this city, ending with a wine tasting in one of the Port Wine Cellars. In the afternoon go to Santa Catarina Street, pedestrian street and excellent for shopping. Still on this street do not forget to visit one of the most beautiful cafes in Portugal - Majestic Café - taste a cake and drink a coffee. It is a MUST, be sure of that! Return to hotel. Accommodation.

DIA 3

At Gaia dock, board the Blue Boat and discover the Porto City seen from one of its most characteristic perspectives: the Douro River! The 6 bridges cruise gives you the opportunity to admire the old part of the city, with the typical houses of Ribeira, while admiring the architecture of the bridges that connect the two banks. Crossing the Ponte D. Luis I and you arrive at the Cais da Ribeira. Visit the Church of S. Francisco, built in the 14th century as part of a Franciscan Convent in a fantastic Gothic style. Next to the Church of San Francisco stands the imposing Stocking Exchange Palace, neoclassical style, built in 1842 and reflecting the commercial flourishing of the city at that time. It is one of the ex-libris and poles of tourist attraction of the city and the region. Return to hotel.

DAY 4

An unforgettable tour of the Minho Region, rich, full of history and beautiful natural landscapes. The city of Guimarães, cradle of nationality and home of the first Portuguese king. It was elected European Capital of Culture 2012. The historical center was classified by Unesco as World Heritage. Free lunch at a local restaurant. Next is

the city of Braga, founded under the name of "Bracara Augusta" during the Roman Empire, is currently one of the oldest Christian cities in the world, known as the "city of archbishops". It was elected European Capital of Youth 2012. Visit of the historical center and the old Cathedral, as well as the Sanctuaries of Sameiro and Bom Jesus. Return to the hotel in Porto. Accommodation.

DAY 5

In the morning you will visit Aveiro. The "Venice of Portugal" is known for the beauty of its water channels, one of the most interesting natural formations along the coast of this country. Traditionally linked to the river and the sea, in Aveiro you will be able to feel the culture of the city, present in its streets that still reminisce the fishing village that once was this city. Typical boats called Moliceiros, the sweets called "ovos moles", the salt and tile facades are some of the unique charms of this city. Return to Porto. Rest of the day at leisure. Accommodation.

DAY 6

Take a stroll through the Douro River Valley and get to know the beauty and magic of this landscape. You will have the opportunity to visit three different wine producing estates and to taste different varieties of wines produced in the Douro Valley in their corresponding demarcated areas: Douro Valley table wine, Quinta Tedo Port Wine, and Vinho Verde from Aveleda. Lunch is included and you can enjoy some delicacies of the Portuguese gastronomy accompanied by a good table wine produced in this region. Return to hotel. Accommodation.

DAY 7

It's your last day in the city and you've had the opportunity to get to know it by bus and boat ... now it's time to take a helicopter city tour, a fantastic aerial tour over the 6 bridges and the Port wine cellars for 30 minutes. Indulge in flight with the historic architectural richness of the city center. Finally, you also have the possibility of traveling on an electric centennial tram that runs through

downtown (the Baixa) and the historical center of Porto. Do not miss this opportunity! Return to the hotel and overnight.

DAY 8

Transfer to the Airport. Assistance and boarding in a flight back home.
