











SINTRA FULL DAY TOUR (WITH LUNCH)

We set off from Lisbon for the impressive and romantic Pena Palace, located on one of the highest peaks in Sintra Natural Park. Take lunch while viewing rather special views out over the surrounding mountains. We then set off for Colares, a demarcated wine region with quite a reputation. We then move onto Cabo da Roca, the most westerly point of continental Europe. We then visit the cosmopolitan town of Cascais, before making our return to Lisbon along the coastline in front of Estoril, with views out over the Casino and its gardens.

EVORA FULL DAY TOUR (WITH LUNCH)

We embark on a one-day voyage through the city of Evora – UNESCO World Heritage –, a mosaic of culture, history and traditions. We cross a pleasant landscape dotted with cork oaks, olive groves and vineyards, before arriving at Evora: the Roman Temple, the Romanesque-Gothic Cathedral, the Church of São Francisco and its Chapel of Bones as well as the University. Following lunch, we set off in direction of the peaceful city of Reguengos de Monsaraz. Here we visit one of the most historical and important wine cellars in the country. Then, we make our return to Lisbon.

FATIMA FULL DAY TOUR (WITH LUNCH) –VISITING OBIDOS, ALCOBAÇA, NAZARE AND BATALHA

We depart first to encounter Óbidos and meet its medieval walls, rustic white houses and the rich and varied local traditions of the town. We then leave Óbidos for Alcobaça to take in the imposing monastery church (UNESCO World Heritage), the first Gothic church to be built in Portugal. We then head onto the picturesque and colourful fishing town of Nazaré for lunch. We then move onto Batalha to visit the Monastery (also UNESCO World Heritage), a real Gothic masterpiece . Finally, we reach the Our Lady of Fátima Sanctuary, an altar of the Christian faith and site of world pilgrimage. And we return back to Lisbon.

ARRABIDA & SESIMBRA HALF DAY TOUR

After crossing 25 of April Bridge, we'll stop at Sesimbra, a well-known village, with its beaches and fish restaurants. Later on, in Azeitão, we're going to visit one of the oldest and most important wine cellars in Portugal, and taste the traditional Moscatel wine. Panoramic view of the beautiful Arrábida Mountain Range and stop at Setúbal, before returning to Lisbon by Vasco da Gama Bridge.
